GHOSTS HAUNT THE MORDECAI HOUSE? NSPIR SET TO FIND OUT.

NSPIR Awarded Contract for Paranormal Investigation of Mordecai Historic Park

According to Mordecai Historic Park staff, guests sometimes notice activities inside the house that are unusual and unexplainable. Sightings of an apparition of a woman thought to be a Mordecai descendent, patches of cold air in the hallways at times when the rest of the house was warm from the summer air, or the sound of silverware rattling in a drawer when no one else was present in the room are some examples of the reported occurrences.

The Mordecai House, built by Joel Lane in 1785, is Raleigh, North Carolina's oldest standing mansion and is listed on the National Historic Register. It has been the site of several past paranormal investigations and has been featured on an episode of the SciFi Channel's highly popular show Ghost Hunters. Further paranormal investigation of the house and grounds is scheduled to begin later this summer as part of a contract recently awarded to the National Society of Paranormal Investigation and Research (NSPIR), with the results to be presented at the annual Haunted Mordecai event on October 24, 2009.

NSPIR, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is one of North Carolina's most professional and respected paranormal investigation and research companies. NSPIR has successfully investigated other historic properties around the United States, including the Battleship North Carolina and Fort Fisher State Historic Site in North Carolina and Ferry Plantation House in Virginia Beach VA.

Mordecai Historic Park is located at 1 Mimosa Street in Raleigh , North Carolina .
