

## **Biography of George C. Matthis, Jr., CEO/President**



A Co-Founder of the National Society of Paranormal Investigation and Research, Incorporated, George has led or participated in more than 50 paranormal investigations since 1997. These investigations have ranged from private residences to large outdoor complexes, including such famous structures as the Battleship North Carolina and the Fort Fisher State Historic Site. George is actively involved with the Rhine Research Center, a world renowned parapsychological research

organization located in Durham, NC, on various projects designed to increase public awareness of this field of study. Since 1993 George has managed a diverse staff of technical and administrative employees with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), assisting homeowners, small and large businesses, and other state and federal government agencies. Earlier in his career he held various technical positions with DENR and was responsible for complex scientific studies and permitting issues. He has an extensive background of public speaking on various science-related topics and was the chairman of the State Fund Administrator's Association from 1996 to 2000, a national association of state environmental cleanup fund managers. He holds a BS in Marine Biology from the University of North Carolina at Wilmington, a MS in Administration from Central Michigan University, and is a Certified Public Manager. George is a Full Member of the Rhine Research Center, an Associate Member of the Parapsychological Association and also a member of the American Association of Electronic Voice Phenomena. George was appointed to the Board of Directors for the Ferry Plantation House in Virginia Beach Virginia, a non-profit historic site, in 2009.
